K4Health Custom Search

K4Health offers users and partners a one-stop shop to efficiently search, organize, and update reproductive health and related information in easy-to-manage formats.

Powered by the Google Search Appliance, K4Health Custom Searches provide users an efficient and smart way to find relevant information quickly without having to re-enter search terms. By entering a search term once in the search box, a user can choose to search a specific resource – within one or all of K4Health Toolkits, for instance – or expand the search to selected databases, the entire K4Health portal, or the World Wide Web.

K4Health Databases

K4Health Databases are vast and growing, currently housing some 425,000 documents and photos. In an effort to foster better health outcomes, as well as to fill knowledge gaps uncovered over time, partners and organizations are encouraged to submit their documents for consideration in K4Health.

POPLine® (www.popline.org) provides electronic access at no cost to over 367,000 records that have been collected over the past 35 years related to the world's population, family planning, and reproductive health literature.

HIVLine (www.k4health/hivline.org) consists of some 40,000 records covering HIV/AIDS topics in international public health settings. It houses information about HIV prevention, treatment, care and support, including integration with family planning services.

Photoshare (www.photoshare.org) is a leading editorial photography collection developed exclusively for nonprofit educational use to help communicate health and development issues through photography. Photoshare is available free of charge to K4Health users.

K4Health Gateways

K4Health Gateways provide users the ability to search numerous Web sites from one location, eliminating the need to conduct extensive searches on multiple sites. The sites included are authoritative sources of relevant information on reproductive health and HIV/AIDS.

Reproductive Health Gateway (www.rhgateway.org) is a collection of 140 carefully selected Web sites that house relevant and reliable information for health professionals. Sites include United Nations, World Bank, World Health Organization, the Pan American Health Organization, and the Global Health Council to name a few.

HIV/AIDS Gateway (www.k4health.org/hivgateway) allows users to search 250 carefully selected Web sites with a click of the button to find quality information on HIV/AIDS.
